






1) Demographic transformation




- 2050: Africa = ¼ world population (2,5 bio)




Externalities: A consequence of an activity which affects other parties or generations without being reflected in current prices or actions.




PM25=particle mass with aerodynamic diameter less than 2.5 µm.

- Cochrane 2018: Nurses substitute doctors in PHC




