 Bulgaria, Croatia, Poland, Spain, Romania, Turkey, etc...

Who are they?

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New set of actors:

- NGOs, think tanks, social media, legal organisations
- 2. Religious inspired / secular in appearance
- Adjacent to mainstream conservative world
- 4. Appear 'respectable'
- 5. Links with alt and farright

Discourse:

Expanded areas of focus, from anti-abortion to:

- 1. SRHR
- 2. LGBTQI
- 3. Gender
- 4. Children's rights
- 5. Religious freedom

Core ideas & strategies

Core ideas?

Common Manifesto: "Restoring the Natural Order"

"Not based on religious beliefs, but on "Natural Law"

- 1. Life: conception to natural death
- Family: traditional, heterosexual, patriarchal, sanctified union between man and woman
- 3. Freedom: Equality and anti-discrimination exempt private sector (gender quotas, sexual orientation, etc.)

Agenda Europe Strategies

... not be afraid to be 'unrealistic' or 'extremist' in choosing our policy objectives

- 1. Positioning themselves as "new real victims"
- 2. Frame issues in terms of "rights" (conscience clauses)
- 3. Damage opponents: "abortion lobby, lesbian lobby and gay lobby" defund them
- Become respected interlocutor at international level

Political Network for Values Strategies

Prioritize Topics:

- **De-fund IPPF:** legal and political work supported by civil society campaigns
- Surrogacy of motherhood: prevention and legislation
- Marriage: prevent and/or reverse changes on definition
- Abortion: 1-prevent / 2-restrict / 3-ban
- Euthanasia and assisted suicide: 1-prevent / 2-ban
- Family: language and good proposals for national policy plans and laws
- Parent's rights on children's education: language and legislative proposals
- Conscientious objection rights: legal and political action
- Religious freedom

Define Actions at the different levels (global / local):

- · Global: UN
- **Regional**: OAS, CARICOM, EU, Council of Europe, African Union, Pan-Pacific
- **Local**: Governments and local administrations; National Parliaments...









Funding

Funding

- Total: \$ 707.2 M
- From 54 NGOs, foundations, religious organisations, and political parties
- From three geographic origins :
 - o USA \$81.3M (11.5%)
 - Russia \$188.2M (26.6%)
 - o EU \$437.7M (66.9%)
- 4X increase over 10 years

Results

Results: Agenda Europe Policy To-do List

10 page action list: long-, medium- and short-term targets:

Examples:	To prohibit	To adopt	Non-legislative actions
Marriage and family	Repeal all laws allowing divorce	Anti-sodomy laws	Defund LBGT and abortion lobbies

Results

Mixed:

- ➤ Significant set-backs in some countries: Poland, Hungary
- ➤ Halted proposed/anticipated progress on key issues (IVF, equal marriage, Istanbul Convention, etc...) in some countries
- ➤ European Institutions → little impact (EU, CoE, PACE)
 - ➤ But trying: ECtHR → Ordo Iuris founder nominated a candidate for PL and cases before ECtHR
- ➤ Retrenched at national level : PL, HU
 - Using new narratives, eg. 'demography'
 - > Part of 'de-democratisation' process in Europe

Concluding thoughts

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 Anti-gender are most impactful when able to strike in 'ambush' → important to raise awareness

 Anti-gender fear the light of day → important to draw attention and place them under democratic scrutiny (funding, transparency, leadership, association/links, past positions)

Where are they now?

- Retreated from European decision-making spaces (Brussels, Strasbourg) since 2018
- Retrenched to safe national bastions: Warsaw, Budapest, Madrid, London.... Rome
- US example of Dobbs (overturning Roe V Wade) → judicial infiltration is a successful strategy
- Expanding to new horizons → Africa is new hotspot

What can we do?

1) Discover and disrobe

Research and communications agenda

2) Disarm

Understand and neutralize strategies

3) Dislocate

Evict from decision-making places & influential positions

4) Demonetise

Seek to disrupt their fundraising

5) Defend

- Defend front-line activist
- Better legal protection for SRHR, human rights and democracy
