Health activists around the world are celebrating the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Alma-Ata Declaration. The Network Medicus Mundi Switzerland (MMS) will use the occasion to debate deeply on the way to achieve health for all until 2030. The results of the reflections will be published in November 2018 in a new [Manifesto](#). As part of this reflection process MMS will organize this workshop to develop answers on the question how international health cooperation has to develop or to change for contributing to health for all.
